Ryoma History Museum

Reliving the Experience of Ryoma's Tumultuous Life

This is the only museum in the world that reproduces Kochi's hero Ryoma Sakamoto's life during the late Tokugawa period using wax figures. Time travel back to historic moments and feel the "Ryoma Spirit" from the incredibly lifelike wax figures.


Meet the historical heroes!

World Classic Car Museum

Manufacturing 100 years ago





This is one of only two premium cars in the world—one which fundamentally changed the concept of cars. This is a museum which displays classic cars of high rarity and value. Please enjoy our unique art and state-of-the-art engineering to your heart's content.

Nee-Owoo African Gallery

The Creative View of the World Woven by Metals




This is a museum which holds the largest collection of work by Nee-Owoo, an artist from Republic of Ghana in Africa. This type of African art uses four kinds of metals and metallic textures to create a unique vision.

Bonnet Bus Museum

Fusion of Nostalgia and Novelty




The museum displays bonnet buses, which played an active role in transportation until the mid-Showa period. These bonnet buses which were left behind or virtually discarded have now been revived in the present age.

Kuma's Container Gallery

Heat and power rises from his work!

The museum contains the work of Katsuyuki Shinohara, also known as "Kuma-san," displayed in four containers. The containers are lit up and create fantastic atmosphere at night.

World Model Car Museum

Over 3,700 palm-sized model cars

This is the first museum to display about 3,700 palm-sized cars. Enjoy the finest model car collection in the world, including Ferrari and Lamborghini models that are legendary in automotive history—an adult hobbyist's dream.
